HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of Shawn 4 Denise Johnson, a long-time resident of Waukegan, who passed 5 away on September 20, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Shawn Johnson was licensed as an instructor in cosmetology and as a nail technician; she was the CEO and founder of the Image Beauty Institute, the first and only State of Illinois Department of Regulations Nail Technology School in Waukegan; opening in December of 2014, the Image Beauty Institute has graduated over 30 students who have successfully passed the State of Illinois State Board Exam to become professionally licensed nail technicians; five of these graduates have opened beautiful salons around the Lake County area; she also developed, published, and founded the From Jails to Nails Life Management Skills Reentry Program; this curriculum-based program helps support individuals with non-violent convictions transition back into the community after incarceration; and

WHEREAS, Shawn Johnson will especially be remembered for volunteering a great deal of her time to help make the city a better place to live not only for herself and her family but for women having problems with recidivism and those that
