1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

- 3 member of the Aurora Exchange Club and the Kane County Bar
- 4 Association; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Alderman O'Connor is married to Mary, a retired
- 6 teacher who taught for over two decades at East Aurora
- 7 District 131; they have two sons, Tom, who is married to Teresa
- 8 Waldinger, and John; therefore, be it
