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HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Other states and countries have developed 3 effective methods of correctional reform by traveling beyond 4 state and national borders; and

5 WHEREAS, These methods have allowed states to rethink and 6 restructure correctional systems, which has led to lower 7 recidivism rates and prison populations; and

8 WHEREAS, The recent widespread and dangerous contagion of 9 COVID-19 in prison facilities provides a timely opportunity 10 for public safety stakeholders to recognize the flaws in 11 Illinois' correctional system; and

12 WHEREAS, Illinois' correctional system can benefit from 13 the implementation of effective incarceration policies, 14 programs, and best practices that aim to reduce correctional 15 spending, alleviate inmate overcrowding at correctional 16 facilities, lower recidivism, and address other challenges; 17 and

18 WHEREAS, Recognition of effective incarceration policies 19 used by other jurisdictions would provide Illinois with 20 possible solutions to improve its correctional system; and 1 WHEREAS, The month of March is nationally recognized as 2 Criminal Justice Month, which is coordinated by the Academy of 3 Criminal Justice Sciences along with the United States 4 Government to promote societal awareness of the causes of 5 crime as well as strategies for prevention and responding to 6 crime; therefore, be it

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7 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE 8 HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 9 we declare the week of March 8, 2022 through March 16, 2022, in 10 coordination with National Criminal Justice Month, as Illinois 11 Correctional Reform Week in the state of Illinois to raise 12 awareness of the benefits of looking beyond state borders for 13 effective methods of correctional reform.
