11 WHEREAS, Illinois residents and all Americans deserve to 12 live in communities that promote safe driving behaviors and 13 healthy lifestyles; and

14 WHEREAS, Preventing distracted driving injuries and deaths 15 requires the cooperation of all levels of government, 16 employers, and the general public; and

17 WHEREAS, The National Safety Council and the Iowa-Illinois 18 Safety Council work to promote policies, practices, and 19 procedures that lead to increased safety and protection and 20 health in business and industry, in schools and colleges, on HR0795 -2- LRB102 27064 MST 38407 r roads and highways, and in homes and communities; and
