1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

- 2 WHEREAS, The Potawatomi Trail of Death was the forced 3 removal by militia in 1838 of approximately 859 members of the 4 Potawatomi nation from Indiana to reservation lands in what is 5 now eastern Kansas; and
- WHEREAS, During the journey to Kansas, 42 people died, 28 of them children; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Trail of Death passed through Decatur in what 9 is now Mueller Park; and
- 10 WHEREAS, A historical marker known as The Rock was placed 11 in Mueller Park on Lake Shore Drive in 1994 by Zita and Bernard 12 Wright to commemorate the trail; and
- 13 WHEREAS, There is no road sign directing people to the 14 historical marker; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
 HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
 the Illinois Department of Transportation is requested to
 erect at suitable locations, consistent with State and federal
 regulations, appropriate plaques or signs directing people to
 the location of the Trail of Death historical marker; and be it
