SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/9-254 new

Amends the Public Utilities Act. Provides that a public utility providing electric service to less than 800,000 customers may not charge non-residential customers a rate from June through September that is more than 10% higher than the rate charged from October through May. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding
5 Section 9-254 as follows:

6 (220 ILCS 5/9-254 new)

7 Sec. 9-254. Winter to summer rates. Notwithstanding any
8 provision of law to the contrary, a public utility providing
9 electric service to less than 800,000 customers may not charge
10 non-residential customers a rate from June through September
11 that is more than 10% higher than the rate charged from October
12 through May.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
14 becoming law.
