Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

ARTICLE 1

The amount of \$2,424,100, or so much thereof 5 Section 5. 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 7 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet its operational 8 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$381,800, or so much thereof as may 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses associated 11 12 with the administration and enforcement associated with the P-13 20 Longitudinal Education Data System Act.

Section 15. The sum of \$183,300, or so much thereof as may 14 15 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 16 the Board of Higher Education for costs associated with the My Credits Transfer System. 17

18 Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 19

1 to the Board of Higher Education for administrative and 2 personnel costs associated with reimbursements to public 3 universities for participation in "The Common Application" 4 System.

5 Section 25. The following named amount, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 7 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as grants 8 authorized by the Higher Education Cooperation Act:

Section 60. The sum of \$980,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of higher education.

6 Section 65. The sum of \$1,055,700, or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 8 to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the Board of 9 Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for the 10 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.

Section 70. The sum of \$100,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Distance Learning Fund to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with the administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 145/40.

Section 75. The amount of \$600,000, or so much thereof as 16 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Academic Quality 18 Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental 19 support for costs and expenses associated with the 20 administration and enforcement of 110 ILCS 1010.

Section 90. The amount of \$650,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Private Business and Vocational Schools Quality Assurance Fund to the Board of Higher Education as supplemental support for costs and expenses associated with the administration and enforcement of the Private Business and Vocational Schools Act of 2012.

Section 95. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under the terms and conditions associated with the federal contracts and grants moneys received. 1 Section 100. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as 2 maybe necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 3 to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses 4 associated with the implementation of the new strategic plan.
