## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

The sum of \$3,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 13 to the Department of Veterans' Affairs for the payment of 14 15 scholarships to students who are dependents of Illinois 16 resident military personnel declared to be prisoners of war, 17 missing in action, killed or permanently disabled, as provided 18 by law.
