

1 AN ACT concerning government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Township Code is amended by adding Article  
5 28A as follows:

6 (60 ILCS 1/Art. 28A heading new)

7 ARTICLE 28A. DISCONTINUANCE OF TOWNSHIP

8 ORGANIZATION: CENTREVILLE TOWNSHIP

9 (60 ILCS 1/28A-5 new)

10 Sec. 28A-5. Applicability. This Article shall apply only  
11 to Centreville Township in St. Clair County.

12 (60 ILCS 1/28A-10 new)

13 Sec. 28A-10. Cessation of township organization. On the  
14 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General  
15 Assembly, Centreville Township is discontinued and abolished  
16 and all the rights, powers, duties, assets, property,  
17 liabilities, obligations, and responsibilities of Centreville  
18 Township shall by operation of law vest in and be assumed by  
19 the City of Cahokia Heights, including the authority to levy  
20 property taxes for township purposes in the same manner as the  
21 dissolved Township. On the effective date of this amendatory

1 Act of the 102nd General Assembly, the terms of office of all  
2 elected and appointed officers of Centreville Township are  
3 ended, and all such offices are discontinued and abolished.

4 (60 ILCS 1/28A-15 new)

5 Sec. 28A-15. Duties and responsibilities of Cahokia  
6 Heights. Upon the effective date of discontinuance and  
7 abolition of Centreville Township, Cahokia Heights shall  
8 exercise all duties and responsibilities of the township  
9 officers as provided in the Township Code, the Illinois Public  
10 Aid Code, the Property Tax Code, and the Illinois Highway  
11 Code, as applicable. Cahokia Heights may enter into an  
12 intergovernmental agreement or contract with the county or the  
13 State to administer the duties and responsibilities of the  
14 township officers for services under its jurisdiction.

15 (60 ILCS 1/28A-20 new)

16 Sec. 28A-20. Business, records, and property of  
17 Centreville Township. The records of Centreville Township  
18 shall be deposited in the city clerk's office of Cahokia  
19 Heights. Cahokia Heights may close up all unfinished business  
20 of the Township and sell and dispose of any of the property  
21 belonging to the Township for benefit of the inhabitants of  
22 Cahokia Heights.
