1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 928

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 928 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Township Code is amended by adding Article  
5 Article 28A as follows:

6 (60 ILCS 1/Art. Art. 28A heading new)

7 ARTICLE Art. 28A. DISCONTINUANCE OF TOWNSHIP

8 ORGANIZATION: CENTREVILLE TOWNSHIP

9 (60 ILCS 1/28A-5 new)

10 Sec. 28A-5. Applicability. This Article shall apply only  
11 to Centreville Township in St. Clair County.

12 (60 ILCS 1/28A-10 new)

13 Sec. 28A-10. Cessation of township organization. On the  
14 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General

1 Assembly, Centreville Township is discontinued and abolished  
2 and all the rights, powers, duties, assets, property,  
3 liabilities, obligations, and responsibilities of Centreville  
4 Township shall by operation of law vest in and be assumed by  
5 the City of Cahokia Heights, including the authority to levy  
6 property taxes for township purposes in the same manner as the  
7 dissolved Township. On the effective date of this amendatory  
8 Act of the 102nd General Assembly, the terms of office of all  
9 elected and appointed officers of Centreville Township are  
10 ended, and all such offices are discontinued and abolished.

11 (60 ILCS 1/28A-15 new)

12 Sec. 28A-15. Duties and responsibilities of Cahokia  
13 Heights. Upon the effective date of discontinuance and  
14 abolition of Centreville Township, Cahokia Heights shall  
15 exercise all duties and responsibilities of the township  
16 officers as provided in the Township Code, the Illinois Public  
17 Aid Code, the Property Tax Code, and the Illinois Highway  
18 Code, as applicable. Cahokia Heights may enter into an  
19 intergovernmental agreement or contract with the county or the  
20 State to administer the duties and responsibilities of the  
21 township officers for services under its jurisdiction.

22 (60 ILCS 1/28A-20 new)

23 Sec. 28A-20. Business, records, and property of  
24 Centreville Township. The records of Centreville Township

1 shall be deposited in the city clerk's office of Cahokia  
2 Heights. Cahokia Heights may close up all unfinished business  
3 of the Township and sell and dispose of any of the property  
4 belonging to the Township for benefit of the inhabitants of  
5 Cahokia Heights."
