However, the property being transferred 3 4 to the Village must be continuous to other Illinois and 5 Michigan Canal lands owned by the Village. (b) Prior to an exchange under subsection (a) with a 6 nongovernmental entity, the Village board shall hold a public 7 8 hearing in order to consider the proposed exchange.
