Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Fire Protection Training Act is amended by changing Section 8 as follows:
- 6 (50 ILCS 740/8) (from Ch. 85, par. 538)
- Sec. 8. Rules and minimum standards for schools. The Office shall adopt rules and minimum standards for such schools which shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
- a. Minimum courses of study, resources, facilities,

 apparatus, equipment, reference material, established

 records and procedures as determined by the Office.
- 14 b. Minimum requirements for instructors.
- Minimum basic training requirements, which a 15 16 trainee must satisfactorily complete before being eligible for permanent employment as a firefighter in the fire 17 department of a participating local governmental agency. 18 19 Those requirements shall include training in first aid 20 (including cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and τ training in 21 the administration of opioid antagonists as defined in 22 paragraph (1) of subsection (e) of Section 5-23 of the Substance Use Disorder Act, and training in the history of 2.3
