AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Fire Protection Training Act is 5 amended by changing Section 8 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 740/8) (from Ch. 85, par. 538)

7 Sec. 8. Rules and minimum standards for schools. The 8 Office shall adopt rules and minimum standards for such 9 schools which shall include, but not be limited to, the 10 following:

a. Minimum courses of study, resources, facilities,
 apparatus, equipment, reference material, established
 records and procedures as determined by the Office.

b. Minimum requirements for instructors.

Minimum basic training requirements, which a 15 с. 16 trainee must satisfactorily complete before being eligible 17 for permanent employment as a firefighter in the fire department of a participating local governmental agency. 18 19 Those requirements shall include training in first aid 20 (including cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and τ training in 21 the administration of opioid antagonists as defined in 22 paragraph (1) of subsection (e) of Section 5-23 of the Substance Use Disorder Act, and training in the history of 23

1the fire service labor movement using curriculum and2instructors provided by a statewide organization3representing professional union firefighters in Illinois.

d. Training in effective recognition of and responses
to stress, trauma, and post-traumatic stress experienced
by firefighters that is consistent with Section 25 of the
Illinois Mental Health First Aid Training Act in a peer
setting.
