1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2065

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2065 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Unemployment Insurance Act is amended by
5 adding Section 1502.5 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 405/1502.5 new)

7 Sec. 1502.5. Benefit charges.

8 A. With respect to any benefits that are paid for a week of
9 unemployment that begins on or after January 3, 2021, and
10 before September 4, 2021, and would not have been paid but for
11 subsection D of Section 612, notwithstanding any other
12 provisions to the contrary, an employer that is subject to the
13 payment of contributions shall not be chargeable for any
14 benefit charges.

15 B. With respect to any regular benefits paid for a week of
16 unemployment that begins on or after January 3, 2021, and

1 before September 4, 2021, and would not have been paid but for
2 subsection D of Section 612, notwithstanding any other
3 provisions to the contrary except subsection E of Section
4 1502.4, a nonprofit organization that is subject to making
5 payments in lieu of contributions shall be chargeable for 50%
6 of the benefits paid if the week begins before April 4, 2021,
7 and 75% if the week begins on or after April 4, 2021.

8 C. With respect to any benefits paid for a week of
9 unemployment that begins on or after January 3, 2021, and
10 before September 4, 2021, and would not have been paid but for
11 subsection D of Section 612, notwithstanding any other
12 provisions to the contrary except subsection E of Section
13 1502.4 and irrespective of whether the State or local
14 government paid the individual who received the benefits wages
15 for insured work during the individual's base period, the
16 State and any local government that is subject to making
17 payments in lieu of contributions shall be chargeable for 50%
18 of the benefits paid if the week begins before April 4, 2021,
19 and 75% if the week begins on or after April 4, 2021.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
21 becoming law."
