SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, Hair Braiding, and Nail Technology Act of 1985. Provides that, in determining compliance with continuing education requirements, the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation shall accept online continuing education that has a verified attendance system completed by a licensee before January 1, 2022. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, Hair 5 Braiding, and Nail Technology Act of 1985 is amended by 6 changing Sections 3-7, 3A-6, 3C-8, and 3E-5 as follows:

8 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2026)

9 Sec. 3-7. Licensure; renewal; continuing education. The holder of a license issued under this Article III may renew 10 that license during the month preceding the expiration date 11 thereof by paying the required fee, giving such evidence as 12 the Department may prescribe of completing not less than 14 13 14 hours of continuing education for a cosmetologist, and 24 hours of continuing education for a cosmetology teacher or 15 cosmetology clinic teacher, within the 2 years prior to 16 renewal. The training shall be in subjects approved by the 17 Department as prescribed by rule upon recommendation of the 18 19 Board and may include online instruction. In determining 20 compliance with the continuing education requirements of this 21 Section, the Department shall accept online continuing 22 education that has a verified attendance system completed by a licensee before January 1, 2022. 23

For the initial renewal of a cosmetologist's license which 1 2 requires continuing education, as prescribed by rule, one hour of the continuing education shall include domestic violence 3 and sexual assault awareness education as prescribed by rule 4 5 of the Department. For every subsequent renewal of a cosmetologist's license, one hour of the continuing education 6 7 may include domestic violence and sexual assault awareness 8 education as prescribed by rule of the Department. The 9 one-hour domestic violence and sexual assault awareness 10 continuing education course shall be provided by a continuing 11 education provider approved by the Department, except that 12 completion from March 12, 2016 to March 15, 2016 of a one-hour 13 domestic violence and sexual assault awareness course from a domestic violence and sexual assault awareness organization 14 15 shall satisfy this requirement.

16 The Department may prescribe rules regarding the 17 requirements for domestic violence and sexual assault 18 awareness continuing education courses and teachers.

The Department shall establish by rule a means for the 19 20 verification of completion of the continuing education 21 required by this Section. This verification may be 22 accomplished through audits of records maintained bv 23 registrants, by requiring the filing of continuing education 24 certificates with the Department, or by other means 25 established by the Department.

Sec. 3A-6. Licensure; renewal; continuing education; examination; military service. The holder of a license issued under this Article may renew such license during the month preceding the expiration date thereof by paying the required fee, giving evidence the Department may prescribe of completing not less than 10 hours for estheticians, and not less than 20 hours of continuing education for esthetics teachers, within the 2 years prior to renewal. The training shall be in subjects, approved by the Department as prescribed by rule upon recommendation of the Board.

5 For the initial renewal of an esthetician's license which requires continuing education, as prescribed by rule, one hour 6 of the continuing education shall include domestic violence 7 8 and sexual assault awareness education as prescribed by rule 9 of the Department. For every subsequent renewal of an 10 esthetician's license, one hour of the continuing education 11 may include domestic violence and sexual assault awareness 12 education as prescribed by rule of the Department. The 13 one-hour domestic violence and sexual assault awareness continuing education course shall be provided by a continuing 14 15 education provider approved by the Department, except that 16 completion from March 12, 2016 to March 15, 2016 of a one-hour 17 domestic violence and sexual assault awareness course from a domestic violence and sexual assault awareness organization 18 19 shall satisfy this requirement.

In determining compliance with the continuing education requirements of this Section, the Department shall accept online continuing education that has a verified attendance system completed by a licensee before January 1, 2022.

The Department may prescribe rules regarding the requirements for domestic violence and sexual assault awareness continuing education courses and teachers.

Sec. 3C-8. License renewal; expiration; continuing education; persons in military service. The holder of a license issued under this Article may renew that license during the month preceding the expiration date of the license by paying the required fee and giving evidence, as the

Department may prescribe, of completing not less than 10 hours 1 2 of continuing education for a nail technician and 20 hours of 3 continuing education for a nail technology teacher, within the 2 years prior to renewal. The continuing education shall be in 4 subjects approved by the Department upon recommendation of the 5 Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, Hair Braiding, and Nail 6 Technology Board relating to the practice of nail technology, 7 including, but not limited to, review of sanitary procedures, 8 9 review of chemical service procedures, review of this Act, and 10 review of the Workers' Compensation Act. However, at least 10 11 of the hours of continuing education required for a nail 12 technology teacher shall be in subjects relating to teaching methodology, educational psychology, and classroom management 13 or in other subjects related to teaching. 14

For the initial renewal of a nail technician's license 15 16 which requires continuing education, as prescribed by rule, 17 one hour of the continuing education shall include domestic violence and sexual assault awareness education as prescribed 18 19 by rule of the Department. For every subsequent renewal of a 20 nail technician's license, one hour of the continuing education may include domestic violence and sexual assault 21 22 awareness education as prescribed by rule of the Department. 23 The one-hour domestic violence and sexual assault awareness continuing education course shall be provided by a continuing 24 25 education provider approved by the Department, except that completion from March 12, 2016 to March 15, 2016 of a one-hour 26

5 Sec. 3E-5. License renewal. To renew a license issued
6 under this Article, an individual must produce proof of
7 successful completion of 10 hours of continuing education for
8 a hair braider license and 20 hours of continuing education
9 for a hair braiding teacher license.

10 For the initial renewal of a hair braider's license which 11 requires continuing education, as prescribed by rule, one hour 12 of the continuing education shall include domestic violence 13 and sexual assault awareness education as prescribed by rule 14 of the Department. For every subsequent renewal of a hair 15 braider's license, one hour of the continuing education may 16 include domestic violence and sexual assault awareness education as prescribed by rule of the Department. 17 The one-hour domestic violence and sexual assault awareness 18 19 continuing education course shall be provided by a continuing 20 education provider approved by the Department, except that 21 completion from March 12, 2016 to March 15, 2016 of a one-hour 22 domestic violence and sexual assault awareness course from a domestic violence and sexual assault awareness organization 23 24 shall satisfy this requirement.
