1	"The copy of the criminal history record information to be
2	provided under this Section shall exclude the identity of the
3	child victim. The superintendent shall be restricted from
4	specifically revealing the <u>identity</u> name of the victim without
5	written consent of the victim or victim's parent or guardian.
6	Nothing in this Article precludes or may be used to preclude a
7	mandated reporter from reporting child abuse or child neglect
8	as required under the Abused and Neglected Child Reporting
9	<u>Act.</u>
10	A court may prohibit such disclosure only after giving
