1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2662

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2662 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Identification Card Act is  
5 amended by changing Section 8 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 335/8) (from Ch. 124, par. 28)

7 Sec. 8. Expiration.

8 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Section:

9 (1) Every identification card issued hereunder, except  
10 to persons who have reached their 15th birthday, but are  
11 not yet 21 years of age, persons who are 65 years of age or  
12 older, and persons who are issued an Illinois Person with  
13 a Disability Identification Card, shall expire 5 years  
14 from the ensuing birthday of the applicant and a renewal  
15 shall expire 5 years thereafter.

16 (2) Every original or renewal identification card

1 issued to a person who has reached his or her 15th  
2 birthday, but is not yet 21 years of age shall expire 3  
3 months after the person's 21st birthday.

4 (b) Except as provided elsewhere in this Section, every  
5 original, renewal, or duplicate: (i) non-REAL ID  
6 identification card issued to a person who has reached his or  
7 her 65th birthday shall be permanent and need not be renewed;  
8 (ii) REAL ID compliant identification card issued on or after  
9 July 1, 2017, to a person who has reached his or her 65th  
10 birthday shall expire 8 years thereafter; (iii) non-REAL ID  
11 Illinois Person with a Disability Identification Card issued  
12 to a qualifying person shall expire 10 years thereafter; and  
13 (iv) REAL ID compliant Illinois Person with a Disability  
14 Identification Card issued on or after July 1, 2017, shall  
15 expire 8 years thereafter. The Secretary of State shall  
16 promulgate rules setting forth the conditions and criteria for  
17 the renewal of all Illinois Person with a Disability  
18 Identification Cards.

19 (c) Every identification card or Illinois Person with a  
20 Disability Identification Card issued under this Act to an  
21 applicant who is not a United States citizen or permanent  
22 resident, ~~other than a conditional permanent resident,~~ or an  
23 individual who has an approved application for asylum in the  
24 United States or has entered the United States in refugee  
25 status, shall expire on whichever is the earlier date of the  
26 following:

1 (1) as provided under subsection (a) or (b) of this  
2 Section;

3 (2) on the date the applicant's authorized stay in the  
4 United States terminates; or

5 (3) if the applicant's authorized stay is indefinite  
6 and the applicant is applying for a Limited Term REAL ID  
7 compliant identification card, one year from the date of  
8 issuance of the card.

9 (d) Every REAL ID compliant identification card or REAL ID  
10 compliant Person with a Disability Identification Card issued  
11 under this Act to an applicant who is not a United States  
12 citizen or permanent resident, ~~other than a conditional~~  
13 ~~permanent resident,~~ or an individual who has an approved  
14 application for asylum in the United States or has entered the  
15 United States in refugee status, shall be marked "Limited  
16 Term".
