Appropriates \$42,321,300 from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Elections for operational expenses, grants, reimbursements for its ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2021.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. In addition to other sums appropriated, the sum of \$19,068,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Elections for operational expenses, grants, reimbursements, and the Census 2020 Redistricting Program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.

10 Section 10. The following amounts, or so much of those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated 11 12 from the Personal Property Tax Replacement Fund to the State 13 Board of Elections for its ordinary and contingent expenses as 14 follows: 15 For reimbursement to counties for increased compensation 16 judges and other election officials, as provided in Public Acts 81-850, 81-1149, and 90-672 - Election 17 18 Day Judges only .....\$1,700,000 For payment of lump sum awards to county clerks, county 19 20 recorders, and chief election clerks as compensation for 21 additional duties required of such officials by consolidation 22 of elections law, as provided in Public Acts 82-691
