1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3082

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3082 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 3. The High-Speed Railway Commission Act is
5 amended by changing Section 5 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 4102/5)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2027)

8 Sec. 5. Commission created; membership.

9 (a) There is created the High-Speed Railway Commission to
10 carry out the duties set forth in Section 10.

11 (b) The Commission shall be composed of the following
12 members:

13 (1) The Governor or his or her designee.

14 (2) The President of the Senate or his or her
15 designee.

16 (3) The Minority Leader of the Senate or his or her

1 designee.

2 (4) The Speaker of the House of Representatives or his
3 or her designee.

4 (5) The Minority Leader of the House of
5 Representatives or his or her designee.

6 (6) The Secretary of Transportation or his or her
7 designee.

8 (7) The Chairperson of the Illinois State Toll Highway
9 Authority or his or her designee.

10 (8) The Chairperson of the Illinois Commerce
11 Commission or his or her designee.

12 (9) The Chairperson of the Commuter Rail Board ~~Board~~
13 ~~of Directors of Metra~~ or his or her designee.

14 (10) The Mayor of the City of Chicago or his or her
15 designee.

16 (11) A representative of a labor organization
17 representing rail workers, appointed by the Governor.

18 (12) A representative of a trade organization related
19 to the rail industry, appointed by the Governor.

20 (13) A representative of the Metropolitan Mayors and
21 Managers Association, appointed by the Governor.

22 (14) A representative from the Illinois Railroad
23 Association, appointed by the Governor.

24 (15) A representative from the University of Illinois
25 System, appointed by the Governor.

26 (16) A representative from the Chicago Metropolitan

1 Agency for Planning, appointed by the Governor.

2 (17) A representative of the Illinois Municipal
3 League, appointed by the Governor.

4 (18) A representative of the Champaign-Urbana Mass
5 Transit District, appointed by the Governor.

6 (19) A representative of the Region 1 Planning
7 Council, appointed by the Governor.

8 (20) A representative of the McLean County Regional
9 Planning Commission, appointed by the Governor.

10 (21) A representative of the East-West Gateway Council
11 of Governments, appointed by the Governor.

12 (c) The Chairperson of the Commission shall be elected
13 from the Commission's membership by a simple majority vote of
14 the total membership of the Commission. The Vice-Chairperson
15 of the Commission shall be elected from the Commission's
16 membership by a simple majority vote of the total membership
17 of the Commission.

18 (d) Appointments made by the Governor under subsection (b)
19 shall be made no later than January 1, 2023 ~~The Governor,~~
20 ~~President of the Senate, Minority Leader of the Senate,~~
21 ~~Speaker of the House of Representatives, and Minority Leader~~
22 ~~of the House of Representatives shall make their initial~~
23 ~~appointments to the Commission by January 1, 2022.~~

24 (e) Vacancies in Commission membership shall be filled in
25 the same manner as provided under subsection (b) ~~initial~~
26 ~~appointments.~~

1 (f) Total membership of the Commission consists of the
2 number of members serving on the Commission, not including any
3 vacant positions. A quorum consists of a simple majority of
4 total membership and shall be sufficient to conduct the
5 business of the Commission, unless stipulated otherwise in the
6 bylaws of the Commission.

7 (g) The Commission shall meet at least quarterly, and hold
8 its first meeting within 30 days after the appointment of
9 members under subsection (d).

10 (h) Members of the Commission shall receive no
11 compensation for service as members.

13 Section 5. The Local Journalism Task Force Act is amended
14 by changing Sections 10 and 25 as follows:

15 (20 ILCS 4108/10)

16 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2024)

17 Sec. 10. Membership.

18 (a) The Task Force shall include the following members:
19 one member of the House of Representatives appointed by the
20 Speaker of the House of Representatives; one member of the
21 House of Representatives appointed by the Minority Leader of
22 the House of Representatives; one member of the Senate
23 appointed by the President of the Senate; one member of the
24 Senate appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate; and one

1 member appointed by the Governor.

2 (b) The Task Force shall also include the following
3 members appointed by the Governor: one representative of the
4 Chicago News Guild; one representative of the Chicago Chapter
5 of the National Association of Broadcast Employees and
6 Technicians-Communication Workers of America; one
7 representative of the Medill School of Journalism, Media,
8 Integrated Marketing Communications at Northwestern
9 University; one representative of the Public Affairs Reporting
10 Program at the University of Illinois at Springfield; one
11 representative of the School of Journalism at Southern
12 Illinois University Carbondale; one representative of the
13 Illinois Press Association; one representative of the Illinois
14 Broadcasters Association; one representative of the Illinois
15 Legislative Correspondents Association; one representative of
16 the Illinois Public Broadcasting Council; one representative
17 of the Illinois News Broadcasters Association; one
18 representative of the University of Illinois at
19 Urbana-Champaign; one representative of the Chicago
20 Independent Media Alliance; one representative of the National
21 Association of Black Journalists; one representative of the
22 Association of LGBTQ Journalists; one representative of the
23 National Association of Hispanic Journalists; one
24 representative of the Asian American Journalists Association;
25 one representative of the Native American Journalists
26 Association; and one representative of the Illinois Municipal

1 League.

2 (c) Appointments shall be made no later than 30 days
3 following the effective date of this Act. Any additional
4 appointments made pursuant to this amendatory Act of the 102nd
5 General Assembly shall be made no later than 30 days following
6 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General
7 Assembly.
