

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 SB3459

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1805/28.7

Amends the Military Code of Illinois. Provides that when any Illinois resident dies while on State Active Duty, the Adjutant General, the Assistant Adjutant General for Army, or the Assistant Adjutant General for Air shall present one State flag of Illinois to the next of kin of the deceased who receives the United States burial flag, or that person's designee, as soon as is practicable.

1 AN ACT concerning the military.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Military Code of Illinois is amended by changing Section 28.7 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 1805/28.7)
- 7 Sec. 28.7. Presentation of State flag. When a member of the Illinois National Guard or any Illinois resident dies 8 9 while on State Active Duty or while serving in duty or training statuses pursuant to Title 10 or Title 32 of the United States 10 Code as approved by the member's service component, the 11 Adjutant General, the Assistant Adjutant General for Army, or 12 the Assistant Adjutant General for Air shall present one State 13 14 flag of Illinois to the next of kin of the deceased Illinois National Guard member who receives the United States burial 15 16 flag, or that person's designee, as soon as is practicable.
