5 Program guidance. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency  
6 shall update the Illinois Water Quality Management Program by  
7 June 30, 2024 and the Illinois Nonpoint Source Management  
8 Program by June 30, 2023.

9 Updates to the Illinois Water Quality Management Program  
10 and the Illinois Nonpoint Source Management Program shall  
11 consider incorporating the following, without limitation: (1)  
12 the findings of the NLRs; (2) an evaluation of adaptive  
13 management opportunities in response to risk to the State's  
14 water resources presented by climate change; and (3)  
15 strategies to improve access to funding and technical  
16 assistance programs by socially disadvantaged communities.

17 Updates to the Illinois Water Quality Management Program  
18 shall also include discussion of potential opportunities to  
19 develop a sponsorship lending program to promote collaboration  
20 within priority watersheds and to promote coordination between  
21 traditional gray and green infrastructure improvements such as  
22 land acquisition and ecosystem restoration, especially in  
23 regard to directing resources to socially disadvantaged  
24 communities and environmental justice areas."; and

2 State-managed"; and

3 on page 17, line 21, by replacing "to a third party" with "from  
4 the State"; and

5 by deleting line 1 on page 18 through line 20 on page 19.".
