SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-806.75 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the standard registration fee for electric vehicles shall be waived for any vehicle owner who is a volunteer firefighter or emergency services personnel. Provides that the new provisions do not apply to the fee set forth for electric vehicles.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding

 Section 3-806.75 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-806.75 new)
- Sec. 3-806.75. Registration fees for volunteer firemen and emergency medical services personnel.
- 9 (a) Beginning with the first registration year commencing after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd 10 General Assembly, the standard registration fee set forth in 11 Section 3-806 for passenger motor vehicles of the first 12 division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing 13 14 not more than 8,000 pounds and registered under Section 3-815 shall be waived for any Illinois vehicle owner who is a 15 16 volunteer firefighter or emergency medical services personnel.
- 17 <u>(b) This Section does not apply to the fee set forth in</u>
 18 Section 3-805 for electric vehicles.
