

102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 SB3741

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/11-20-17 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that every municipality shall inspect all single-family residences and multi-family buildings in the municipality built before 1978 for the presence of lead paint and lead piping by June 1, 2024. Provides that after an inspection of each single-family residence or a multi-family building, the inspector shall file a report of the inspector's findings with the clerk of the municipality. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 11-20-17 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/11-20-17 new)
- 7 Sec. 11-20-17. Lead paint and pipe inspections.
- 8 (a) Every municipality shall inspect all single-family
- 9 <u>residences and multi-family buildings</u> in the municipality
- 10 built before 1978 for the presence of lead paint and lead
- 11 piping by June 1, 2024.
- 12 <u>(b) After an inspection of each single-family residence or</u>
- a multi-family building, the inspector shall file a report of
- 14 the inspector's findings with the clerk of the municipality.
- 15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 16 becoming law.
