4	adult students receiving special education services in the
5	computation of completion rates for purposes of public school
6	accountability, when computing completion rates under Section
7	10-17a, the State Superintendent of Education shall include
8	students who:
9	(1) are at least 18 years of age as of September 1 of
10	the school year as reported for the fall semester and have
11	satisfied the credit requirements for high school
12	graduation;
13	(2) have not completed their individualized education
14	program in accordance with Section 14-1.02 of this Code
15	and the federal Individuals with Disabilities Education
16	Act (20 U.S.C. Section 1400 et seq.); and
17	(3) are enrolled and receiving individualized
18	education program services.".
