2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 4000 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by

8	(a) If any person receiving a disability retirement
9	pension from the Fund is re-employed as a teacher by an
10	Employer, the pension shall be cancelled on the date the
11	re-employment begins, or on the first day of a payroll period
12	for which service credit was validated, whichever is earlier.
13	(b) If any person receiving a service retirement pension
14	from the Fund is re-employed as a teacher on a permanent or
15	annual basis by an Employer, the pension shall be cancelled on
16	the date the re-employment begins, or on the first day of a

payroll period for which service credit was validated, whichever is earlier. However, subject to the limitations and requirements of subsection (c-5), the pension shall not be cancelled in the case of a service retirement pensioner who is re-employed on a temporary and non-annual basis or on an hourly basis.

(c) If the date of re-employment on a permanent or annual 7 8 basis occurs within 5 school months after the date of previous 9 retirement, exclusive of any vacation period, the member shall 10 be deemed to have been out of service only temporarily and not 11 permanently retired. Such person shall be entitled to pension payments for the time he could have been employed as a teacher 12 13 and received salary, but shall not be entitled to pension for 14 or during the summer vacation prior to his return to service.

When the member again retires on pension, the time of service and the money contributed by him during re-employment shall be added to the time and money previously credited. Such person must acquire 3 consecutive years of additional contributing service before he may retire again on a pension at a rate and under conditions other than those in force or attained at the time of his previous retirement.

(c-5) For school years beginning on or after July 1, 2022, the service retirement pension shall not be cancelled in the case of a service retirement pensioner who is re-employed as a teacher or administrator on a temporary and non-annual basis or on an hourly basis, so long as the person (1) does not work 10200SB4000sam001 -3- LRB102 23374 RPS 35643 a

1 as a teacher or administrator for compensation on more than 120 days in a school year or (2) in the case of a person who 2 retires with at least 5 years of service as a principal or 3 4 administrator, does not work as a teacher or administrator for 5 compensation on more than 140 days in a school year. These 6 limitations apply only to school years that begin on or after July 1, 2022. Such re-employment does not require 7 contributions, result in service credit, or constitute active 8 9 membership in the Fund.

10 For school years beginning on or after July 1, 2019 and 11 before July 1, 2022, the service retirement pension shall not be cancelled in the case of a service retirement pensioner who 12 13 is re-employed as a teacher on a temporary and non-annual 14 basis or on an hourly basis, so long as the person (1) does not 15 work as a teacher for compensation on more than 120 days in a 16 school year or (2) does not accept gross compensation for the re-employment in a school year in excess of (i) \$30,000 or (ii) 17 in the case of a person who retires with at least 5 years of 18 service as a principal, an amount that is equal to the daily 19 20 rate normally paid to retired principals multiplied by 100. 21 These limitations apply only to school years that begin on or after July 1, 2019 and before July 1, 2022. Such re-employment 22 does not require contributions, result in service credit, or 23 24 constitute active membership in the Fund.

Notwithstanding the 120-day or 140-day limit set forth in 14 15 $\frac{1}{1}$ of this subsection (c-5), the service retirement 16 pension shall not be cancelled in the case of a service retirement pensioner who teaches only driver education courses 17 after regular school hours and does not teach any other 18 19 subject area, so long as the person does not work as a teacher 20 for compensation for more than 900 hours in a school year. For school years beginning before July 1, 2022, the The \$30,000 21 limit set forth in subitem (i) of item (2) of this subsection 22 23 (c-5) shall apply to a service retirement pensioner who 24 teaches only driver education courses after regular school 25 hours and does not teach any other subject area.

1 of pension, the pensioner must notify the Fund and the Board of Education of his or her intention to accept re-employment 2 (c-5) before 3 under this subsection beginning that 4 re-employment (or if the re-employment began before the 5 effective date of this amendatory Act, then within 30 days after that effective date). 6

An Employer must certify to the Fund the temporary and non-annual or hourly status and the compensation of each pensioner re-employed under this subsection at least quarterly, and when the pensioner is approaching the earnings limitation under this subsection <u>if an earnings limitation</u> <u>applies</u>.

13 If the pensioner works more than 100 days or accepts 14 excess gross compensation for such re-employment in any school 15 year that begins on or after August 8, 2012 (the effective date 16 of Public Act 97-912), the service retirement pension shall 17 thereupon be cancelled.

18 If the pensioner who only teaches drivers education 19 courses after regular school hours works more than 900 hours 20 or accepts excess gross compensation, if a limitation on the 21 <u>amount of gross compensation applies</u>, for such re-employment 22 in any school year that begins on or after the effective date 23 of this amendatory Act of the 99th General Assembly, the 24 service retirement pension shall thereupon be cancelled.
