Introduced 2/1/2022, by Sen. Don Harmon

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$22,682,800 from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Elections for operational expenses, grants, and reimbursements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023. Appropriates \$4,954,000 from the Personal Property Tax Replacement Fund to the State Board of Elections for specified purposes. Reappropriates \$14,525,000, or so much of those amounts as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2022, from an appropriation made for specified purposes in Public Act 102-0017. Effective July 1, 2022.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. In addition to other sums appropriated, the sum
5 of \$22,682,800, or so much of that sum as may be necessary, is
6 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board
7 of Elections for operational expenses, grants, and
8 reimbursements for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

9 Section 10. The following amounts, or so much of those
10 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
11 from the Personal Property Tax Replacement Fund to the State
12 Board of Elections for its ordinary and contingent expenses as
13 follows:

14	For reimbursement to counties for increased compensation	
15	judges and other election officials, as provided in	
16	Public Acts 81-850, 81-1149, and 90-672 - Election	
17	Day Judges only	\$4,200,000
18	For payment of lump sum awards to county clerks, county	
19	recorders, and chief election clerks as a compensation for	
20	additional duties required of such officials by consolidation	
21	of elections law, as provided in Public Acts 82-691	
22	and 90-713	<u>\$754,000</u>

2 Section 15. The following amounts, or so much of those
3 amounts as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close
4 of business on June 30, 2022, from an appropriation heretofore
5 made for that purpose in Section 15 of Article 38 of Public Act
6 102-0017, are reappropriated from the Help Illinois Vote Fund
7 to the State Board of Elections for implementation of the Help
8 America Vote Act of 2002:

9 For the implementation of the Statewide Voter Registration
10 system, as required by Section 1A-25 of the Election Code,
11 including maintenance of the
12 IDEA/VISTA program \$621,000
13 For administrative costs and discretionary grants to local
14 election authorities under Section 101 of the Health America
15 Vote Act of 2002\$91,300
16 For administrative costs and discretionary grants to local
17 election authorities under the 2018 & 2020 HAVA Election
18 Security Grant\$13,812,700
19 Total \$14,525,000.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
21 2022.
