SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Employment Security for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, as follows:

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. In addition to any other sums appropriated, the 6 sum of \$405,377,800 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 7 appropriated from the Title III Social Security and Employment 8 Fund to the Department of Employment Security for operational 9 expenses, awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the 10 fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, including prior year costs.
