1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

- Section 5. The amount of \$9,271,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Executive Ethics Commission for its ordinary and contingent expenses.
- 9 Section 10. The amount of \$1,015,000, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Road Fund to the 11 Executive Ethics Commission for its ordinary and contingent 12 expenses.
- Section 15. The amount of \$837,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital Development Board Revolving Fund to the Executive Ethics Commission for its ordinary and contingent expenses.
- Section 20. The amount of \$1,061,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Professional Services Fund to the Executive Ethics Commission for its

- 1 ordinary and contingent expenses.
- 2 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,
