WHEREAS, Rick Glass was born in Akron, Ohio to Robert and Marilyn (Basford) Glass on February 1, 1948; he graduated from Joliet West in 1966 and the University of Cincinnati in 1971; he earned his master's degree in Hospital and Healthcare Administration from Xavier University in 1978; he married Barbara on October 30 1982; together, they raised their three children in Peoria and later in Bloomington-Normal; and
