Inspection of connections to residential rental properties and individual rental units. 8 (a) A unit of local government may request that an 9 electric cooperative or municipal system inspect the 10 connection to a meter in a specified residential rental 11 12 property or the submeter in an individual rental unit to which 13 it delivers utility services to ensure that the billing of the property or unit is accurate. The electric cooperative or 14 15 municipal system shall inspect the property or unit within 60

days after receipt of the request.
