#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.85 new 105 ILCS 5/34-18.82 new

Amends the School Code. Requires a school board to ensure parents and guardians of pupils enrolled in the school district are free to petition the school board and provide public comment at all public and regularly scheduled meetings, have access to certain information, are well-informed on specified subject matters, and have the right to meet with a pupil's teacher at least twice per school year. Requires a school board to ensure curriculum and learning materials are posted on the school district's Internet website. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
  10-20.85 and 34-18.82 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.85 new) 7 Sec. 10-20.85. Parents' rights. Notwithstanding any other law or rule to the contrary, each school board shall ensure all 8 9 of the following: (1) That the parents and guardians of all pupils 10 enrolled in the school district are free to petition the 11 12 school board and provide public comment at all public and regularly scheduled school board meetings. 13 14 (2) That all curriculum and learning materials used by the schools of the school district are posted on the 15 16 school district's Internet website if the school district 17 maintains a website, disaggregated by grade level. If the school district does not maintain an Internet website, all 18 parents and guardians of pupils shall be informed of their 19 20 right to review all curriculum and learning materials used 21 by the schools of the school district at any time during 22 the school year. (3) That the parents and quardians of all pupils 23

5 <u>(4) That the parents and guardians of all pupils</u> 6 <u>enrolled in the school district are well-informed of all</u> 7 <u>parent-school engagement opportunities to ensure parents</u> 8 <u>and guardians are engaged in their children's education.</u>

9 <u>(5) That the school district shares with the parents</u> 10 <u>and quardians of pupils information on the Illinois</u> 11 <u>Learning Standards and any changes made to the Illinois</u> 12 <u>Learning Standards throughout the school year.</u>

(6) That each parent or guardian of a pupil has the 13 14 right to meet with the pupil's teacher at least twice per 15 school year, which may include parent-teacher conferences. (7) That the libraries of each school of the school 16 district maintain a list of reading materials contained in 17 18 the library so that the parents and guardians of pupils 19 are able to request to review the reading materials 20 contained at each school.

21 <u>(8) That the parents and guardians of all pupils</u> 22 <u>enrolled in the school district are well-informed about</u> 23 <u>the educational opportunities provided to pupils within</u> 24 <u>the school district, including, but not limited to, the</u> 25 <u>curriculum, gifted education programs, advanced placement</u> 26 <u>courses, special education needs, the needs of English</u>

3	(9) That the parents and guardians of all pupils

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Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
