

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB1354

Introduced 1/31/2023, by Rep. Dan Ugaste

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 200/30-32 new

Amends the Property Tax Code. Provides that no taxing district may hold more than 150% of the previous levy year's property tax collections in cash or cash-equivalent assets. Provides that excess amounts shall be refunded to taxpayers. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by adding Section 30-32 as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 200/30-32 new)
- Sec. 30-32. Limit on surplus funds. No taxing district may
  hold more than 150% of the previous levy year's property tax

  collections in cash or cash-equivalent assets. If, at the end
  of any fiscal quarter, the taxing district has more than that
  amount in cash or cash-equivalent assets, then the excess
  amount shall be refunded to taxpayers pro rata based on each
  taxpayer's percentage of the total levy for the previous year.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
