Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 10-20.85 and 34-18.82 as follows:

- 14 financial assistance, training, and equipment provided to a
- 15 school by a civic organization or association or any local
- funds a school board expends on establishing and maintaining a
- junior color guard program.
- 18 <u>(b) Subject to</u> the availability of local resources,
- 19 beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, each public middle
- 20 school, junior high school, and high school shall establish a
- junior color guard program to promote the value of and honor
- 22 military personnel. The junior color quard shall be used at
- 23 school events, including interscholastic athletic events and

other events in which the presenting of the colors is 1 2 requested. Each school shall allow the junior color quard to 3 participate in community events in which the presenting of the 4 colors may be requested. Each school may work with a civic 5 organization or association to provide adequate training to the members of the junior color quard on the execution of their 6 7 duties.
