1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2929

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2929 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing
5 Sections 4-14.1 and 5-9.1 and by adding Section 1A-70 as
6 follows:

7 (10 ILCS 5/1A-70 new)

8 Sec. 1A-70. Remove voter form. The State Board of
9 Elections shall create a form to be used by an election
10 authority to remove a voter from its roll.

11 (10 ILCS 5/4-14.1) (from Ch. 46, par. 4-14.1)

12 Sec. 4-14.1. Cancellation of deceased voter's registration.
13 Upon establishment of an electronic reporting system for death
14 registrations as provided in the Vital Records Act, the county
15 clerk of the county where a decedent last resided, as

1 indicated on the decedent's death certificate, shall ~~may~~ issue
2 certifications of death records from that system and shall ~~may~~
3 use that system to cancel the registration of any person who
4 has died during the preceding month. Regardless of whether or
5 not such a system has been established, it is the duty of the
6 county clerk to examine, monthly, the records deposited in his
7 or her office pursuant to the Vital Records Act that relate to
8 deaths in the county, and to cancel the registration of any
9 person who has died during the preceding month. The county
10 clerk shall examine notifications of deaths provided by the
11 county coroner and cancel the registration of any person who
12 has died.

14 (10 ILCS 5/5-9.1) (from Ch. 46, par. 5-9.1)

15 Sec. 5-9.1. Cancellation of deceased voter's registration.
16 Upon establishment of an electronic reporting system for death
17 registrations as provided in the Vital Records Act, the county
18 clerk of the county where a decedent last resided, as
19 indicated on the decedent's death certificate, shall ~~may~~ issue
20 certifications of death records from that system and shall ~~may~~
21 use that system to cancel the registration of any person who
22 has died during the preceding month and cause the name of each
23 such deceased person to be erased from the register of the
24 precinct in which the deceased person was registered.
25 Regardless of whether or not such a system has been

1 established, it is the duty of the county clerk to examine
2 monthly the records deposited in his or her office pursuant to
3 the Vital Records Act that relate to deaths in the county, to
4 cancel the registration of any person who has died during the
5 preceding month and cause the name of each such deceased
6 person to be erased from the register of the precinct in which
7 the deceased person was registered. The county clerk shall
8 examine notifications of deaths provided by the county coroner
9 and cancel the registration of any person who has died.

11 Section 10. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section
12 3-3046 as follows:

13 (55 ILCS 5/3-3046 new)

14 Sec. 3-3046. Notification to county clerk or election
15 authority. A county coroner shall notify the local county
16 clerk or local election authority of records concerning deaths
17 the coroner investigates."
