15	(b) As part of the Future Through Employment for Young
16	Adults Program, the Office shall operate a school-year program

and a summer program as follows:

- (1) The school-year program shall operate during the school year of the district in which the program participant is located. Program participants enrolled in the school-year program will work 12 to 35 hours per week at an employer participating in the program at the rate of \$15 per hour or the prevailing minimum wage in that county, whichever is higher. The Office shall enroll 80,0000 participants in the school-year program.
- (2) The summer program shall operate during the summer break of the district where the program participant is located. Program participants enrolled in the summer program will work 25 hours per week at an employer participating in the program at the rate of \$15 per hour or the prevailing minimum wage in that county, whichever is higher. The Office shall enroll 80,0000 participants in the school-year program.
- organizations that interact with jobless youth and young adults and provide them strong, consistent support to build their work-related skills of showing up on time, working collaboratively with others, following instructions, and other critical skills to place participating students with an employer. The Office shall also coordinate with employers to provide program participants with jobs after training.
 - (d) The Office shall establish eligibility criteria for
