SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 325/8

from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 328

Amends the Recyclable Metal Purchase Registration Law. Provides that any recyclable metal dealer or other person who knowingly fails to record the purchase of 30 or more catalytic converters is guilty of a Class 4 felony.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning business.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Recyclable Metal Purchase Registration Law
5 is amended by changing Section 8 as follows:

6 (815 ILCS 325/8) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 328)

7 Sec. 8. Penalty. Any recyclable metal dealer or other
8 person who knowingly fails to comply with this Act is guilty of
9 a Class A misdemeanor for the first offense, and a Class 4
10 felony for the second or subsequent offense, except that any
11 recyclable metal dealer or other person who knowingly fails to
12 record the purchase of 30 or more catalytic converters is
13 guilty of a Class 4 felony. Each day that any recyclable metal
14 dealer so fails to comply shall constitute a separate offense.
15 Any metal obtained not in accordance with this Act is subject
16 to immediate forfeiture.
