1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The PFAS Reduction Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 40 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 170/40 new)
- 7 Sec. 40. PFAS disposal program. The Agency shall establish
- 8 a take-back program for fire departments that use and store
- 9 firefighting foam containing PFAS. Fire departments that
- 10 participated in the most recent survey described in Section 25
- 11 shall be eligible to participate in the program, but
- 12 participation in the program shall not be required. The
- 13 program shall provide funding and resources to ensure the
- 14 proper disposal or destruction of firefighting foam containing
- 15 PFAS. The program shall continue for a period of 5 years or
- 16 until the Office of the State Fire Marshal finds that no
- firefighting foam containing PFAS is reported in the survey
- 18 described in Section 25. This program is subject to
- 19 appropriation.
- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 21 becoming law.
