SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

25 ILCS 83/110-30 new

Amends the Racial Impact Note Act. Provides that by December 31, 2023, the Office of the Governor shall submit a report to the General Assembly with recommendations regarding the production of statements or notes that a member of the General Assembly may request under the Act. Requires the report to include certain recommendations on methodology, formatting, and a course of training for personnel of certain State agencies. Provides that subject to appropriation, the Office of the Governor may contract with an entity or entities that have expertise in racial impact or equity impact assessments for the production of the report. Repeals these provisions on January 1, 2025. Effective immediately.

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2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Racial Impact Note Act is amended by adding
 Section 110-30 as follows:
- (25 ILCS 83/110-30 new) 6 7 Sec. 110-30. Governor's recommendations regarding the 8 production of statements or notes. 9 (a) By December 31, 2023, the Office of the Governor shall submit a report to the General Assembly with recommendations 10 regarding the production of statements or notes that a member 11 12 of the General Assembly may request under this Act. The report shall include recommendations: 13 14 (1) on the methodology for estimating the impact of proposed legislation on racial and ethnic minorities as 15 16 specified under Section 110-5; (2) for estimating the racial and ethnic composition 17 of the population who may be impacted by proposed 18 19 legislation as specified under Section 110-5;
- 20 (3) on formatting for the production of any statement
 21 <u>or note requested under this Act;</u>
- 22(4) on the methodology for evaluating equitable23outcomes for underserved populations in Illinois pursuant

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to paragraph (10) of subsection (d) of Section 20-15 of 1 2 the Data Governance and Organization to Support Equity and 3 Racial Justice Act; and (5) on a course of training to occur on a regular basis 4 5 for personnel of State agencies that may be required to prepare a statement or note requested under this Act. 6 (b) Subject to appropriation, the Office of the Governor 7 may contract with an entity or entities that have expertise in 8 9 racial impact or equity impact assessments for the production 10 of the report required by this Section. (c) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2025. 11

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
