SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.1012 new 625 ILCS 5/3-699.24 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Allows the Secretary of State to issue special registration plates designated as Navy Club license plates to residents of this State. Creates the Navy Club Fund. Provides that moneys in the Navy Club Fund shall be paid, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and distribution by the Secretary, as grants to each Navy Club located in this State. Makes a conforming change in the State Finance Act.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding 5 Section 5.1012 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/5.1012 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5.1012. The Navy Club Fund.</u>
- 8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding

- 11 <u>Sec. 3-699.24. Navy Club license plates.</u>

12 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of 13 14 State, may issue special registration plates designated as Navy Club license plates to residents of Illinois who meet 15 16 eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. 17 The special plate issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, 18 19 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 20 8,000 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 1-169 of this Code. 1 <u>expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure</u> 2 established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

3 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, except 4 5 that the Navy Club emblem shall appear on the plates. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 6 7 issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 8 9 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe 10 11 the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, 12 shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided 13 under Section 3-412

14 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$5 fee for original 15 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This 16 additional fee shall be deposited into the Navy Club Fund. For 17 each registration renewal period, an \$18 fee, in addition to 18 the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. This 19 additional fee shall be deposited into the Navy Club Fund.

20 (d) The Navy Club Fund is created as a special fund in the
21 State treasury. All moneys in the Navy Club Fund shall be paid,
22 subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and
23 distribution by the Secretary, as grants to each Navy Club
24 located in this State.
