2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4169 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5 Section 5.1012 as follows:

13 Sec. 3-699.14. Universal special license plates.

14 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the

1 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
2 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may
3 issue Universal special license plates to residents of
4 Illinois on behalf of organizations that have been authorized
5 by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special
6 license plates. Appropriate documentation, as determined by
7 the Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized
8 organizations shall be designated by amendment to this
9 Section. When applying for a Universal special license plate
10 the applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the
11 authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a
12 decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record
13 of that organization and that organization shall remain
14 affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered,
15 revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization
16 may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and
17 distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the
18 authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct
19 from any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal,
20 sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal
21 special license plate other than a decal authorized by the
22 General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal
23 sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be
24 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division,
25 including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the
26 second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates

1 issued under this Section shall expire according to the
2 multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

3 (b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special
4 license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the
5 Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required
6 to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection
7 (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The design shall allow for
8 the application of a decal to the plate. Organizations
9 authorized by the General Assembly to issue decals for
10 Universal special license plates shall comply with rules
11 adopted by the Secretary governing the requirements for and
12 approval of Universal special license plate decals. The
13 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow Universal
14 special license plates to be issued as vanity or personalized
15 plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The
16 Secretary of State must make a version of the special
17 registration plates authorized under this Section in a form
18 appropriate for motorcycles and autocycles.

19 (c) When authorizing a Universal special license plate,
20 the General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee
21 is to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged,
22 the amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed.
23 When necessary, the authorizing language shall create a
24 special fund in the State treasury into which fees may be
25 deposited for an authorized Universal special license plate.
26 Additional fees may only be charged if the fee is to be paid

1 over to a State agency or to a charitable entity that is in
2 compliance with the registration and reporting requirements of
3 the Charitable Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.
4 Any charitable entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal
5 special license plates shall annually provide the Secretary of
6 State a letter of compliance issued by the Attorney General
7 verifying that the entity is in compliance with the Charitable
8 Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.

9 (d) Upon original issuance and for each registration
10 renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration
11 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional
12 fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license
13 plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of the
14 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the
15 plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State
16 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into
17 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the
18 organization to issue decals for Universal special license
19 plates. All money in the designated fund shall be distributed
20 by the Secretary subject to appropriation by the General
21 Assembly.

23 Universal special license plates with the original and renewal
24 fees and fee distribution as follows:

3 as grants to the Horsemen's Council of Illinois.

4 (4) The Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness Fund.
5 All money in the Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder Awareness
6 Fund shall be paid as grants to K9s for Veterans, NFP for
7 support, education, and awareness of veterans with
8 post-traumatic stress disorder.

9 (5) The Guide Dogs of America Fund. All money in the
10 Guide Dogs of America Fund shall be paid as grants to the
11 International Guiding Eyes, Inc., doing business as Guide
12 Dogs of America.

15 Mechanics Local 701 Training Fund.

16 (7) The Theresa Tracy Trot - Illinois CancerCare

18 Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund shall be paid to the
19 Illinois CancerCare Foundation for the purpose of
20 furthering pancreatic cancer research.

22 money in the Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund
23 shall be paid as grants to the Illinois Department of
24 Human Services to fund legal aid groups to assist with
25 guardianship fees for private citizens willing to become
26 guardians for individuals with developmental disabilities

1 but who are unable to pay the legal fees associated with
2 becoming a guardian.

3 (9) The Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund. All money in
4 the Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund shall be paid as
5 grants to the Cancer Center at Illinois for pediatric
6 cancer treatment and research.

7 (10) The Folds of Honor Foundation Fund. All money in
8 the Folds of Honor Foundation Fund shall be paid as grants
9 to the Folds of Honor Foundation to aid in providing
10 educational scholarships to military families.

11 (11) The Experimental Aircraft Association Fund. All
12 money in the Experimental Aircraft Association Fund shall
13 be paid, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly
14 and distribution by the Secretary, as grants to promote
15 recreational aviation.

16 (12) The Child Abuse Council of the Quad Cities Fund.
17 All money in the Child Abuse Council of the Quad Cities
18 Fund shall be paid as grants to benefit the Child Abuse
19 Council of the Quad Cities.

20 (13) The Illinois Health Care Workers Benefit Fund.
21 All money in the Illinois Health Care Workers Benefit Fund
22 shall be paid as grants to the Trinity Health Foundation
23 for the benefit of health care workers, doctors, nurses,
24 and others who work in the health care industry in this
25 State.

1 the Future Farmers of America Fund shall be paid as grants
2 to the Illinois Association of Future Farmers of America.
