1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Menstrual Products Donor Immunity Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:
- 7 "Apparently usable" means, with respect to the product,
- 8 that the product meets all quality and labeling standards
- 9 imposed by federal, State, and local laws, rules, and
- 10 regulations, even if the product may not be readily
- 11 marketable.
- "Donor" means a nonprofit organization that donates an
- apparently usable menstrual product to a human recipient for
- 14 ultimate use with respect to menstruation.
- "Menstrual product" means a sanitary napkin, tampon,
- liner, cup, and any similar item used by an individual with
- 17 respect to menstruation.
- 18 Section 10. Nonprofit organization immunity from
- 19 liability. A nonprofit organization that in good faith
- 20 receives menstrual products for distribution without fee or
- 21 compensation and reasonably inspects the menstrual product at
- 22 the time of donation and finds the menstrual product

- apparently usable for humans shall not be liable in any civil 1
- 2 action, except for willful or wanton conduct.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 3
- becoming law. 4
