

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
5 Menstrual Products Donor Immunity Act.

6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:

7 "Apparently usable" means, with respect to the product,
8 that the product meets all quality and labeling standards
9 imposed by federal, State, and local laws, rules, and
10 regulations, even if the product may not be readily
11 marketable.

12 "Donor" means a nonprofit organization that donates an
13 apparently usable menstrual product to a human recipient for
14 ultimate use with respect to menstruation.

15 "Menstrual product" means a sanitary napkin, tampon,
16 liner, cup, and any similar item used by an individual with
17 respect to menstruation.

18 Section 10. Nonprofit organization immunity from
19 liability. A nonprofit organization that in good faith
20 receives menstrual products for distribution without fee or
21 compensation and reasonably inspects the menstrual product at
22 the time of donation and finds the menstrual product

1 apparently usable for humans shall not be liable in any civil
2 action, except for willful or wanton conduct.

3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
4 becoming law.
