SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-699.23 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Allows the Secretary of State to issue special registration plates designated as Air Medal plates to residents of this State who meet the eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. Provides that the plates shall display the Air Medal. Provides that in all other respects, the design, color, and format of the plates shall be within the discretion of the Secretary.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 3-699.23 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.23 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3-699.23. Air Medal license license plates.</u>
- (a) The Secretary of State, upon receipt of all applicable 8 9 fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special registration plates designated as 10 Air Medal plates. The special plates issued under this Section 11 shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first 12 division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second 13 14 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year 15 16 procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
 - (b) The plates shall display the Air Medal. In all other respects, the design and color of the special plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall accompany each application. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates

- 1 are not required to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed
- 2 <u>in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary</u>
- 3 shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or
- 4 her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals
- 5 as provided under Section 3-412.
