A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5 changing Sections 3-806 and 3-815 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-806) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806)

7 Sec. 3-806. Registration Fees; Motor Vehicles of the First
8 Division. Every owner of any other motor vehicle of the first
9 division, except as provided in Sections 3-804, 3-804.01,
10 3-804.3, 3-805, 3-806.3, 3-806.7, and 3-808, and every second
11 division vehicle weighing 8,000 pounds or less, shall pay the
12 Secretary of State an annual registration fee at the following
13 rates:

5 A \$1 surcharge shall be collected in addition to the above
6 fees for motor vehicles of the first division, autocycles,
7 motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and pedalcycles to be
8 deposited into the State Police Vehicle Fund.

9 All of the proceeds of the additional fees imposed by
10 Public Act 96-34 shall be deposited into the Capital Projects
11 Fund.

12 A \$2 surcharge shall be collected in addition to the above
13 fees for motor vehicles of the first division, autocycles,
14 motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and pedalcycles to be
15 deposited into the Park and Conservation Fund for the
16 Department of Natural Resources to use for conservation
17 efforts. The monies deposited into the Park and Conservation
18 Fund under this Section shall not be subject to administrative
19 charges or chargebacks unless otherwise authorized by this
20 Act.

21 Of the fees collected for motor vehicles of the first
22 division other than Autocycles, Motorcycles, Motor Driven
23 Cycles, and Pedalcycles, \$1 of the fees shall be deposited
24 into the Secretary of State Special Services Fund and \$49 of
25 the fees shall be deposited into the Road Fund.

 3 division.

4 (a) Except as provided in Section 3-806.3 and 3-804.3,
 5 every owner of a vehicle of the second division registered
 6 under Section 3-813, and not registered under the mileage
 7 weight tax under Section 3-818, shall pay to the Secretary of
 8 State, for each registration year, for the use of the public
 9 highways, a flat weight tax at the rates set forth in the
 10 following table, the rates including the \$10 registration fee:

8 Beginning with the 2010 registration year a \$1 surcharge
9 shall be collected for vehicles registered in the 8,000 lbs.
10 and less flat weight plate category above to be deposited into
11 the State Police Vehicle Fund.

12 Beginning with the 2014 registration year, a \$2 surcharge
13 shall be collected in addition to the above fees for vehicles
14 registered in the 8,000 lb. and less flat weight plate
15 category as described in this subsection (a) to be deposited
16 into the Park and Conservation Fund for the Department of
17 Natural Resources to use for conservation efforts. The monies
18 deposited into the Park and Conservation Fund under this
19 Section shall not be subject to administrative charges or
20 chargebacks unless otherwise authorized by this Act.

21 Of the fees collected under this subsection, \$1 of the
22 fees shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special
23 Services Fund and \$99 of the fees shall be deposited into the
24 Road Fund.

25 All of the proceeds of the additional fees imposed by
26 Public Act 96-34 shall be deposited into the Capital Projects

1 Fund.

2 (a-1) A Special Hauling Vehicle is a vehicle or
3 combination of vehicles of the second division registered
4 under Section 3-813 transporting asphalt or concrete in the
5 plastic state or a vehicle or combination of vehicles that are
6 subject to the gross weight limitations in subsection (a) of
7 Section 15-111 for which the owner of the vehicle or
8 combination of vehicles has elected to pay, in addition to the
9 registration fee in subsection (a), \$125 to the Secretary of
10 State for each registration year. The Secretary shall
11 designate this class of vehicle as a Special Hauling Vehicle.

12 (a-5) Beginning January 1, 2015, upon the request of the
13 vehicle owner, a \$10 surcharge shall be collected in addition
14 to the above fees for vehicles in the 12,000 lbs. and less flat
15 weight plate categories as described in subsection (a) to be
16 deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate
17 Fund. The \$10 surcharge is to identify vehicles in the 12,000
18 lbs. and less flat weight plate categories as a covered farm
19 vehicle. The \$10 surcharge is an annual, flat fee that shall be
20 based on an applicant's new or existing registration year for
21 each vehicle in the 12,000 lbs. and less flat weight plate
22 categories. A designation as a covered farm vehicle under this
23 subsection (a-5) shall not alter a vehicle's registration as a
24 registration in the 12,000 lbs. or less flat weight category.
25 The Secretary shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
26 this subsection (a-5).

1 (a-10) Beginning January 1, 2019, upon the request of the
2 vehicle owner, the Secretary of State shall collect a \$10
3 surcharge in addition to the fees for second division vehicles
4 in the 8,000 lbs. and less flat weight plate category
5 described in subsection (a) that are issued a registration
6 plate under Article VI of this Chapter. The \$10 surcharge
7 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License
8 Plate Fund. The \$10 surcharge is to identify a vehicle in the
9 8,000 lbs. and less flat weight plate category as a covered
10 farm vehicle. The \$10 surcharge is an annual, flat fee that
11 shall be based on an applicant's new or existing registration
12 year for each vehicle in the 8,000 lbs. and less flat weight
13 plate category. A designation as a covered farm vehicle under
14 this subsection (a-10) shall not alter a vehicle's
15 registration in the 8,000 lbs. or less flat weight category.
16 The Secretary shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
17 this subsection (a-10).

18 (b) Except as provided in Section 3-806.3, every camping
19 trailer, motor home, mini motor home, travel trailer, truck
20 camper or van camper used primarily for recreational purposes,
21 and not used commercially, nor for hire, nor owned by a
22 commercial business, may be registered for each registration
23 year upon the filing of a proper application and the payment of
24 a registration fee and highway use tax, according to the
25 following table of fees:

 16 3-819.

17 (c) Farm Truck. Any truck used exclusively for the owner's
 18 own agricultural, horticultural or livestock raising
 19 operations and not-for-hire only, or any truck used only in
 20 the transportation for-hire of seasonal, fresh, perishable
 21 fruit or vegetables from farm to the point of first
 22 processing, may be registered by the owner under this
 23 paragraph in lieu of registration under paragraph (a), upon
 24 filing of a proper application and the payment of the \$10
 25 registration fee and the highway use tax herein specified as
 26 follows:

Of the fees collected under this subsection, \$1 of the fees shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special Services Fund and \$99 of the fees shall be deposited into the Road Fund.

In the event the Secretary of State revokes a farm truck registration as authorized by law, the owner shall pay the flat weight tax due hereunder before operating such truck.

Any combination of vehicles having 5 axles, with a distance of 42 feet or less between extreme axles, that are subject to the weight limitations in subsection (a) of Section

1 15-111 for which the owner of the combination of vehicles has
2 elected to pay, in addition to the registration fee in
3 subsection (c), \$125 to the Secretary of State for each
4 registration year shall be designated by the Secretary as a
5 Special Hauling Vehicle.

6 (d) The number of axles necessary to carry the maximum
7 load provided shall be determined from Chapter 15 of this
8 Code.

9 (e) An owner may only apply for and receive 5 farm truck
10 registrations, and only 2 of those 5 vehicles shall exceed
11 59,500 gross weight in pounds per vehicle.

12 (f) Every person convicted of violating this Section by
13 failure to pay the appropriate flat weight tax to the
14 Secretary of State as set forth in the above tables shall be
15 punished as provided for in Section 3-401.
