7 <u>Sec. 21-106. Judicial order; findings of fact.</u>

(a) Legislative intent. Residents of this State who were 8 9 born in another state or in another country may have difficulty in securing a birth certificate with the correct 10 information. It is the intent of the General Assembly that 11 Illinois should have a legal process available for these 12 residents to seek a judicial order making findings of fact so 13 14 that they may petition the issuing jurisdiction to change a birth certificate. 15

16 <u>(b) An Illinois resident may file a petition in the</u> 17 <u>resident's county of residence asking for a court to issue a</u> 18 <u>finding of fact or facts to correct or update a birth</u> 19 <u>certificate issued by another state or country.</u>

(c) The petition must contain the following information:

21 (1) the petitioner's name and current address;

- 22 (2) the change that is sought; and
- 23 (3) the reason for the change.
