SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 505/2EEEE new

Amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. Provides that it is an unlawful practice for any person who hosts an online distribution platform for third-party software programs or applications to charge a fee or commission on a purchase made by a customer through a software program or application that was distributed through that platform. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
- 5 Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2EEEE as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2EEEE new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2EEEE. Fees or commissions on third-party software</u>
- 8 programs and applications. No person who hosts an online
- 9 distribution platform for third-party software programs or
- 10 applications shall charge a fee or commission on a purchase
- 11 made by a customer through a software program or application
- that was distributed through that platform.
- Any person who violates this Section commits an unlawful
- 14 practice within the meaning of this Act.
- 15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 16 becoming law.
