

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB5853

Introduced 5/22/2024, by Rep. Anthony DeLuca

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 20/3

from Ch. 144, par. 2603

Amends the College Student Immunization Act. Provides that, beginning with the 2024-2025 academic year, for a tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis vaccine (Tdap) requirement, if a student who enrolls in a post-secondary educational institution cannot provide the dates on which the student received 3 or more doses of a diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis containing vaccine, then the student must provide at least one date on which the student received a dose of the vaccine not more than 10 years prior to the beginning of the term of current enrollment. Provides that additional doses of either a Tdap vaccine or a tetanus and diphtheria vaccine shall be administered in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention catch-up schedule, as needed, to complete a series of at least 3 doses, including any prior doses of specified vaccines. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning education.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The College Student Immunization Act is amended by changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (110 ILCS 20/3) (from Ch. 144, par. 2603)
- 7 Sec. 3. Exceptions.
- 8 (a) The provisions of this Act shall not apply to: (1)
  9 persons enrolled in a post-secondary educational institution
  10 on or before the effective date of this Act; (2) persons
  11 enrolled less than half-time during a term or semester; or (3)
  12 persons whose instruction solely involves research, field work
- or study outside of a classroom environment.
- 14 (b) No proof of immunization shall be required if a 15 physician licensed to practice medicine in all of its branches 16 certifies that any immunization required by the Department is 17 medically contraindicated.
- 18 (c) No proof of immunization shall be required if the 19 person or his or her parent or guardian presents a signed 20 statement that he or she objects to immunizations on religious 21 grounds.
- 22 (d) The certificate of medical exemption or statement of 23 religious objection required by this Section shall be

- presented to the post-secondary educational institution. 1
- (e) Beginning with the 2024-2025 academic year, for a tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis vaccine (Tdap) requirement, 3 if a student who enrolls in a post-secondary educational 4 institution cannot provide the dates on which the student 5 received 3 or more doses of a diphtheria, tetanus, and 6 7 pertussis containing vaccine, then the student must provide at least one date on which the student received a dose of the 8
- 9 vaccine not more than 10 years prior to the beginning of the
- term of current enrollment. Additional doses of either a Tdap 10
- 11 vaccine or a tetanus and diphtheria vaccine shall be
- 12 administered in accordance with the Centers for Disease
- 13 Control and Prevention catch-up schedule, as needed, to
- complete a series of at least 3 doses, including any prior 14
- 15 doses of any of the following:
- 16 (1) Tdap vaccine;
- 17 (2) tetanus and diphtheria vaccine;
- (3) diphtheria and tetanus vaccine; and 18
- (4) diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis vaccine. 19
