

103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB5913

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1305/10-80 new 5 ILCS 100/5-45.55 new

Amends the Department of Human Services Act. Provides that, subject to the reallocation by the General Assembly of moneys appropriated for Illinois Welcoming Centers for State Fiscal Year 2025, the Department of Human Services shall establish a pilot program to pay one-time property tax rebates to qualified applicants. Provides that a qualified applicant is an individual who (i) is responsible for the payment of property taxes for the 2023 tax year, due in 2024, on homestead property located in Bloom, Calumet, Rich, Thornton, or Bremen Township in Cook County and (ii) is a member of a low-income or moderate-income household. Amends the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act to provide for the adoption of emergency rules. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning revenue.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Human Services Act is amended by adding Section 10-80 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 1305/10-80 new)
- 7 Sec. 10-80. Property tax relief pilot program.
- (a) Subject to the reallocation by the General Assembly of 8 9 moneys appropriated for Illinois Welcoming Centers pursuant to 10 Section 15 of Article 63 of Public Act 103-589, the Department shall establish a pilot program to pay one-time property tax 11 12 rebates to qualified applicants who apply with the Department for a rebate under this Section. Only one rebate may be awarded 13 14 for any single parcel of eligible homestead property. Applications shall be submitted to the Department in the form 15 and manner required by the Department by rule. The amount of 16 the rebate provided under this Section shall be determined by 17 the Department; however, the aggregate amount of rebates 18 19 awarded by the Department under this Section may not exceed 20 the total amount reallocated by the General Assembly for that 21 purpose. When determining the amount of the rebate, the 22 Department shall attempt to maximize the number of qualified applicants who receive rebates under this Section. 2.3

- The Department may adopt rules to implement and administer

- 3 (b) As used in this Section:
- 4 "Homestead property" has the meaning given to that term in
- 5 <u>Section 15-175 of the Property Tax Code.</u>
- 6 "Qualified applicant" means an individual who (i) is
- 7 responsible for the payment of property taxes for the 2023 tax
- 8 year, due in 2024, on homestead property located in Bloom,
- 9 <u>Calumet, Rich, Thornton, or Bremen Township in Cook County and</u>
- 10 (ii) is a member of a low-income or moderate-income household,
- 11 as determined by the Department by rule.
- 12 (c) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2026.
- 13 Section 10. The Illinois Administrative Procedure Act is
- amended by adding Section 5-45.55 as follows:
- 15 (5 ILCS 100/5-45.55 new)
- 16 Sec. 5-45.55. Emergency rulemaking; property tax relief
- 17 pilot program. To provide for the expeditious and timely
- 18 implementation of this amendatory Act of the 103rd General
- 19 Assembly, emergency rules implementing the Section 10-80 of
- 20 the Department of Human Services Act may be adopted in
- 21 accordance with Section 5-45 by the Department of Human
- 22 Services. The adoption of emergency rules authorized by
- 23 Section 5-45 and this Section is deemed to be necessary for the
- 24 public interest, safety, and welfare.

- 1 This Section is repealed one year after the effective date
- of this amendatory Act of the 103rd General Assembly.
- 3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 4 becoming law.
