HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of Representatives wish to congratulate Suzanne Simpson on the occasion of her retirement as Warren Township Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, Suzanne Simpson, as the chief executive officer, oversaw all the programs and services offered by the township; she was responsible for the development, use, and maintenance of an 80-acre park complex and served as chairman of the township board and treasurer of all town funds, including general assistance, road, and bridge funds; and

WHEREAS, Suzanne Simpson helped facilitate the expansion of the Warren Township Center, more than doubling its size and creating more space for recreation and others services for seniors; and

WHEREAS, Suzanne Simpson, along with the village of Gurnee, helped implement the Care Trak Program, which is designed to help police locate at-risk children and adults with special needs who may become lost; the program uses radio telemetry technology to find the missing person wearing the specially equipped tracking bracelet in as little as 30 minutes; and

1 WHEREAS, Suzanne Simpson began her political career as a
2 Republican precinct committeeperson from 1988 to 1998; she has
3 served as the Warren Township Supervisor since 1997; she was
4 appointed to represent District 61 in the Illinois House of
5 Representatives in 2002; and

6 WHEREAS, Suzanne Simpson has been a member of the Lake
7 County Republican Federation, the Federation Board of
8 Governors, and the Lake County Farm Bureau Legislative
9 Committee; and

10 WHEREAS, Suzanne Simpson owned and operated Simpson
11 Equipment in Grayslake; therefore, be it
