HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of
3 Representatives wish to congratulate the Salem Community High
4 School (SCHS) bowling team on the occasion of winning the
5 2023-24 Illinois High School Association (IHSA) State
6 Championship; and

7 WHEREAS, The SCHS bowling team came back from a
8 third-place standing following the first day of the two-day
9 tournament to beat Harrisburg High School for the title on
10 Saturday, January 27, attaining a 206.7 per game average over
11 Harrisburg High School's 205.9 per game average; and

12 WHEREAS, SCHS bowling team senior Dominick Winkler
13 finished tenth overall as an individual with 2,604 points,
14 while juniors Ryan Detering finished with 2,490 points, Silas
15 Moats finished with 2,481 points, Keaton Gullion finished with
16 2,453 points, and Rhett Detering finished with 2,374 points;

18 WHEREAS, The SCHS bowling team's latest success marks the
19 second year in a row it has won the IHSA State Final
20 Tournament, becoming one of only two teams in history to win
21 the title back-to-back; and

1 WHEREAS, The SCHS bowling team has now won a total of three
2 state championships, one second place finish, and two third
3 place finishes since the program started in 2003; and

4 WHEREAS, The SCHS bowling team is led by Coach Steve
5 Ludwig and Assistant Coach Maliyah Hamilton; and

6 WHEREAS, Members of the SCHS bowling team include Rhett
7 Detering, Ryan Detering, Evan Gelsinger, Keaton Gullion, Silas
8 Moats, Jaret Rushing, and Dominick Winkler; therefore, be it
